

## CHURCH & MINISTRY MEETING MINUTES

March 7, 2022

9:00am

- I. Meeting opened at 9:05am with a prayer by Dave Rohrer.
- II. Motion to approve January 2022 meeting minutes by Pat Frey, seconded by Barb Simonton. Motion passed.
- III. Old Business:
  - A. Broadcast equipment update: Still waiting on the arrival of the new sound board. Pastor Chris highly recommends not to change any of the settings on the current sound board as changes cause other broadcast issues to occur. Live streaming through new camera system is going well. We are seeing an increase in the number of Sunday viewers.
  - B. Council membership: Dave suggested we continue to look for new members for our Council. We would like to add at least one additional member to our council. Dave reported that his term ends in June.
- IV. New Business
  - A. Fine Arts Committee: Dave Rohrer had nothing new to report.
  - B. Easter Services:
    1. Palm Sunday April 10 – Kim reported palms have been ordered. Palms will be placed on the Alter and will be distributed by two congregational members near the end of service, with each row being dismissed to come forward to get a palm and form a circle around Sanctuary to sing the final hymn. There will also be a “drive through” distribution of palms after the service in the parking lot from 11:30-12:30.
    2. Maundy Thursday April 14 – service will be held at 7pm. Communion will take place from the pews using the communion packets
    3. Good Friday April 15 – will be one service at 7pm.
    4. Easter Sunday April 17 – one service -10:00am. Communion will be from the pews using the communion packets
  - C. Community Baptism: Pastor Chris indicated there will be a community baptism at the April 3 Sunday service.
  - D. Communion procedures: Council discussed when to return to our “normal” communion distribution procedures and decided to wait until the fall to re-evaluate. It was noted that when returning to former communion procedures, Pastor Chris will need to move the mic/stool from front area to accommodate ushers. Pastor Chris indicated it is no problem to give the sermon from the Pulpit.
  - E. Other: It was noted that Barb Simonton had created the flower arrangements currently placed on the Altar. Thank you, Barb!
