

FIRST UCC CONSISTORY MEETING MINUTES  
JUNE 19, 2022

A meeting of the Consistory of First United Church of Christ was held on Sunday, June 19, 2022. The May 2022 Consistory minutes were approved by Pat Frey and seconded by Karen Byers. All approved.

The new slate of Consistory officers will be Mike Coulson – President, Greg Lewis – Vice President, Gail Havens – Secretary and Craig Kern – Treasurer. A motion was made by Mike Coulson to confirm these nominees and seconded by Pat Frey. All approved.

Treasurer's Report: Craig Kern reported donations are down requiring more use of investment money to cover expenses. Stewardship Council is looking for new members.

Council chairs were asked to get their council rosters into Bonnie at the office.

Advisory Council: Wally Eckman is off the council and will be replaced by Pat Frey. The council includes the officers of Consistory plus members at-large.

Property Management Council: Dallas Bailey spoke with McClure and they are expecting parts to come in and hope to get the AC unit for the sanctuary installed in July. The work will require removing some ceiling tiles in the back hallway to Fellowship Hall. This will affect the SPY summer program. Dallas and Ken Stoner will speak with SPY about using the front hallway into Fellowship Hall.

Church and Ministry Council: Council discussed about having greeters at the back door to greet people and for security reasons. It was recommended there be two greeters each Sunday for security. Greg Lewis suggested having a security assessment done. Council will check into this further and the possibility of getting a grant to cover the expense.

COVID report: Greg Lewis reported cases are down in PA and the county. Since January 2020, one in four people have had COVID in PA and one in five have had it the county. Other viruses are occurring like the flu which is becoming more year round then just in fall and winter. No changes were made to our current COVID protocols.

There was no old or new business.
