Hoping to have the meetings in our church space as Covid continues to decline and we can meet in person. Just recently I receive a request to meet with a new grand-family.

I am also meeting with members from our Biddle Mission Labyrinth Board to discuss maintenance and community programs using the labyrinth.

As a Board Member of NAMI, we are at work planning an October Mental Health Walk in Mechanicsburg. We meet at the Giant Camp Hill Meeting Room as it is a large space and we can socially distance.

Beginning last week, I began serving as temporary pastor at Zion UCC in Newburg.

I was invited to serve as a co-trainer with another Question, Refer, Persuade (QPR) program facilitator (suicide prevention) in the Fall.

I am a member of a monthly book group discussing Native American spirituality.

I serve on Church and Community Connections Council and on Christian Education Council.
